Vice President: Fuat Oktay

After graduating from Cukurova University in 1985 with a degree from the Business Department, Oktay worked as a research assistant at the same university. He has completed his master's degree in manufacturing engineering and management at Wayne State University in Detroit, USA in 1990. He has provided consultancy services for both public and private companies. He served as the Undersecretary of Prime Ministry since 19 June 2016.



Minister of Justice: Abdülhamit Gül

Abdülhamit Gül completed his higher education at the Ankara University Faculty of Law. He is a member of the Legal Research Association (MJDÖS) and worked as a self-employed lawyer in Ankara. Gül got elected as the Gazişehir Deputy in 25th and 26th terms. He was elected as AK Party General Secretary in September 2015. In January 2017 he was appointed to the Ministry of Justice.



Minister of Foreign Affairs: Mevlüt Çavuşoğlu

He has organized series of seminars under the title of "Democracy Meetings" to inform citizens about the "yes" vote in 12 September 2010 referendum. He has previously worked as Minister of Labour and Social Security and Minister of Internal Affairs. He is a member of AK Party Central Decision Board of Directors. He has a family business operating in the insurance sector since 1994.



Minister of Defence: Hulusi Akar

Hulusi Akar graduated from the Armed Forces Academy in 1985 and the US Army Forces College in 1987. He was appointed to the Chief of General Staff in 2015. He was on the side of the government against the coup attempt in July 15, and successfully commanded the Turkish Armed forces in the fight against terror and cross-border operations. Prof. Dr. Ziya Selçuk received his undergraduate degree from the Faculty of Education Sciences of Ankara University and had his master's degree in developmental psychology. He is a member of the Scientific and Technological Research Council of Turkey (TÜBİTAK) Group Executive Committee. Minister of Health: Fahrettin Koca

He obtained his pediatric residency and became a Child Health and Disease Specialist in 1995. He was appointed as a board of trustee member to the Istanbul Medipol University. Besides, he is the Vice-Chairman of the Foreign Economic Relations Board (GEB), Education Committee's Business Council and President of the Turkey Exporters Assembly (TİM) Service Exporters Association Health Services Committee.



Minister of Energy and Natural Resources: Fatih Dönmez

Fatih Dönmez has graduated from Yıldız Technical University, Department of Electronics Engineering in 1987 and completed his e-MBA certificate program in 2005. He has worked at various energy and telecommunication companies. He was amongst the founders of the Electricity Industry Association of Turkey (TEİSAB). Dönmez was appointed as a board member to Energy Market Regulatory Authority (EPDK) in 2008 and Undersecretary of Ministry of Energy and Natural Resources in 2015.



Minister of Transportation and Infrastructure: Mehmet Cahit Turan

Cahit Turan graduated from Civil Engineering Department of Karadeniz Technical University and done his masters at the same university. Under the scope of Istanbul 17th regional elections he worked as the chief engineer and regional manager. He served as the Principal Consultant to the Presidency and Member of the Council of State. Minister of Environment and Urbanization: Murat Kurum

Since 2009 he is the General Manager of the Emtek Konut Real Estate Investment Company which is participation of Prime Ministry Housing Development Administration.



Minister of Agriculture and Forestry: Bekir Pakdemirli
